

ROYAL RANGERS TRANS-TITIWANGSA EXPEDITION



Banjaran Titiwangsa is the main mountain range that forms the backbone of Peninsula Malaysia. The Titiwangsa range starts in the north as a continuation of the Phuket mountain range in Southern Thailand, running southeast to Mount Ledang in Johor. This mountain range is a part of the Tenasserim Hills system of Indochina which starts in the Himalayas. The range acts as a natural divider in Peninsular Malaysia, separating the East and West Coast regions.

The highest elevation is the 2,183m (7,162ft) Gunung Korbu and the range is about 480km from north to south. Most of the range is heavily forested, and mainly composed of granite. Three popular resort areas located on this range are Cameron Highlands, Genting Highlands and Fraser's Hill.

The Trans-Titiwangsa Expedition transverses the Titiwangsa mountain range starting from Ulu Kinta, Perak to Blue Valley in Cameron Highland, Pahang. It will cover three of the seven highest mountains in Peninsula Malaysia, Mount Korbu, Mount Gayong and Mount Yong Belar, the 2nd, 3rd and 4th highest mountains respectively. Its breathtaking views and unique 'mossy forests' environment more than make up for the gruelling six day expedition. The Trans-Titiwangsa has been featured as the best multi-day trek in Malaysia.

ITINERARY

Day 1, Saturday – Travel to Ipoh and on to overnight at Ulu Kinta Dam, Perak

Day 2, Sunday – Travel by 4wd to trailhead to begin half day trek to Camp Kijang.

Day 3, Monday – Ascend Mount Korbu and overnight at the Summit.

Day 4, Tuesday – Mount Korbu to Mount Gayong. Descend to overnight at Camp H2O.

Day 5, Wednesday – Ascend to Mount Yong Belar and overnight at the summit.

Day 6, Thursday – Descend Mount Yong Belar to overnight at Camp Gurkha.

Day 7, Friday – Ascend to Mount Challi Pondok and descend to Blue Valley, Cameron Highlands. Travel back to Kuala Lumpur.

Registration is only open to Expedition Rangers aged 15 years and above. All participants must complete;

1. a pre-requisite medical examination prior to the trip and submit their medical certification form.
2. attend all training events organised in preparation for the expedition and be in good physical condition.

Participation Fee: RM520.00 (inclusive of permits, guides and camping fees, tents and group equipment, and transportation. Fee does not include porters, personal equipment and expenses, and meals)
