## **INTRODUCTION**

Freedom is the quality or state of being free. Everyone longs for freedom in life.

Paul the apostle declared; “I am free from all men” and yet said “I have made myself a servant to all”.

What was his purpose? “that I might win the more” (**I COR 9:19**).

## **OUTLINE:**

Paul’s life of being free really stems from his experience from the impact and fact of the power of God evidenced through gospel of Christ (**ROM 1:16, 17**) He clearly exhorts and proclaims that it can be everyone’s experience.

- I. Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God (I COR 10:31)**
  - a) Depend on Him all the time in all things (**PRO 3:5,6, MATT 6:33**).
  - b) His will and way never goes wrong. Seek and know His will, walk in His ways. In a potentially self glorifying world giving God priority in your life has to be a matter of your heart’s devotion to Him. Giving Him glory is not a statement but a life lived out by a walk of faith.
  
- II. Please all men, seek their profit (I COR 10:33)**
  - a) Live for Jesus and you will please others.
  - b) Seek the best for others based on eternal values at heart.

Jesus came for the purpose to give His life for others. It was not just for the moment but for eternity. Everything He did for others was to usher them to His Father.

- III. Imitate Christ in me (I COR 11:1)**
  - a) Follow the example of Christ in others.
  - b) Show Christ through your life.

The surest way to have Christ in you is to have the presence of the Holy Spirit who always makes Jesus so real and true to. Following Jesus is the only way of experiencing true freedom.
