Title: The Day Jesus Came Visiting Your Home

Text : Lk. 10:38-42, Lk.19:2-10, Mt.9:9-17

Intro. : We want to invite Jesus to our home. And if that is your desire, then we need to prepare ourselves and our home to receive Him.

Body : 1. Jesus was welcomed in her home  
Lk. 10:38-42, Jn.12:1-2

Mary is altogether wrapped up in adoration.  
While Martha is all engaged in preparing for Jesus' visit.

*What happens when Jesus visit your home?*

People get saved.

Jesus taught them and give guidance for living. They learn to prioritise. Lk.10:38-42

2. Jesus asked to visit his home  
Lk.19:2-10

Zacchaeus had no time to prepare his home. But he prepared his heart for Jesus to come.

*What happens when Jesus visit your home?*

There is a transformation that took place.

Salvation has come to this home. Lk.19:9.  
This is the eternal purpose of Jesus. 'For the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost.'

It is Jesus who makes the difference.

3. Jesus was scheduled to visit his home  
Mt.9:9-17

This visit is not one to do follow up and discipleship with Matthew. Matthew has learnt much from the Lord by following Jesus in His outreach ministry. He has now grown in his faith and knowledge of Jesus. He now feels the responsibility for the salvation of his business partners, and his former colleagues.

*What happens when Jesus visit your home?*

Jesus is one who satisfy all our longings for significance, sense of worth, teach us and give us strength for right living.

When you are tired of telling lies, scheming, fearful of being found out for the wrongs that you have done, then come to Jesus and 'unload' all these burdens of sin before Jesus.

Conc. :        There is a difference between a home that have Jesus and one that do not have Jesus' presence.
