It Gives Us Hope of Life After Death

Jesus said to Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live" (John 11:25)

Again He said, speaking to His disciples: "... Because I live, you will live also" (John 14:19)

There were two occasions Jesus demonstrated He had the power to give life:

- The 12 years old daughter of Jairus (Luke 8:40-42, 49-56)
- Lazarus, the brother of Mary and Martha (John 11:1-44)

Jesus Himself rose from dead as told by the angels (Matthew 28:1-8)

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.

2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also" (John 14:1-3)
