Title : Trust In God and Rejoice
Text : Psalm 5:11

Trust is a combination of faith and works
Trust is an act of faith.

- To rejoice is the expression of faith.

“But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name Be joyful in You” (Psalm 5:11)

- Faith that God will defend them
 - They trust God for their defense against their enemies
- They love God and rejoice
 - This is the expression of faith.

David’s Confession Of His Faith (Psalm 5:12)

- Our attitude determines our confession.

“For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield” (Psalm 5:12)

- God will bless the righteous
- God’s favor will surround them
- God’s favor is God’s shield

Conclusion: People of Faith Are Joyful People

“The joy of the Lord is your strength” (Nehemiah 8:10)

- When King Jehoshaphat went to battle with the army of Ammon, Moab and Mount Seir, he believed God for victory and sent out the choir to sing praises to God before the army.

“21 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who should sing to the LORD, and who should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army and were saying: “Praise the LORD, For His mercy endures forever.”

27 Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, with Jehoshaphat in front of them, to go back to Jerusalem with joy, for the LORD had made them rejoice over their enemies. 28 So they came to Jerusalem, with stringed instruments and harps and trumpets, to the house of the LORD.

29 And the fear of God was on all the kingdoms of those countries when they heard that the LORD had fought against the enemies of Israel” (2 Chronicles 20:21 & 27-29)
